1. MAJOR ACOMPLISHMENTS

Due to COVID 19 long lock down imposed in Dang district and our all field activities were halted except Radio program and Publication of messages in newspaper. At the last week of June we have made some field visit and supported in EPI clinic as Lock down situation became little flexible.

- 2 Episode of Radio program was recorded and broadcasted.
- CHM recorded 5 Kosheli program among them 2 Kosheli program was broadcasted
- Heath awareness message through newspaper was published 4 times in Yugbodh national daily.(every Sunday)
- Supported in one EPI clinic of Gadhawa Health Post
- Follow up of pregnant women through telephone
- Coordination activities

2. KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

- 121 pregnant women were followed up by CHM via telephone and took update & provided education & support based on their need. Among them 9 pregnant women were suggested/ referred to health facility to sought out their problem (1 for swelling of leg, 4 for USG, 1 for vomiting, 1 for burning micturation, 2 for abdominal pain)
- 12 beneficiaries called for the answer of Kosheli program 1 & 2 at MCHP office, among them MCHP declared 2 winner through lottery number
- During EPI clinic at Gadhawa HP total 65 participants (pregnant mother and guardians) got health education and counseling on different immunization and prevention and control measure of second wave of COVID 19

The 3rd radio program was broadcasted on 5th and 12th of June 2021 which included following section:-

Briefing on COVID 19: The program started with announcement of second wave of COVID 19, its impact on people and prevention and control measure announced by District and Local level.

Voice form pregnant women: Radio staff collected voices from mother group of different community of Gaunpalika regarding what were the problem faced by them due to lockdown, what prevention measure they had applied, problem for pregnancy and children etc

<u>Voice from HP staff</u>: Lalika Chaudhary ANM (Gadhawa HP) explained about how the health facility had been providing the MCH service during lockdown situation

<u>Kosheli Program:</u> 1st Kesheli program was developed and broadcasted regarding information about second wave of COVID 19, Prevention and control, special attention to pregnant women and children

The 4th radio program broadcasted on 19th and 26th June which included following section:-

Briefing about Post natal period: 4th radio program was started with short explanation on definition of postnatal period and its importance.

Voice from PN Mother: In this section the voice form Postnatal mothers of Gaunpalika were broadcasted regarding their daily activities, daily diet practice, breast feeding etc

Voice from HP Staff: Rekha Sharma (ANM-Gangaparaspur HP) talked about timely PNC visit, its importance, danger sign during postnatal period etc

<u>*Kosheli Program:*</u> 2nd Kosheli program was developed and broadcasted regarding Postnatal care and newborn care
