# Objective 1 &2: Attain and maintain HIV epidemic control among at-risk adult men, women and PPs and KPs

### Support group meeting:

### Jhapa:

AMDA EpiC Nepal conducted support group meeting physically on February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022 in Birtamode City Clinic. A total of 9 PLHIV (5 Male and 4 Female) participated in the meeting. Meeting was facilitated by Case manager, PN & Covid Response officers. Discussion was done on COVID-19 & Vaccination, Health Insurance, U=U, ART enrollment and re enrollment of all positive cases, importance of Index based partner testing and COVID-19 vaccination.

## Sunsari

AMDA EpiC Nepal conducted support group meeting on February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022 in Itahari Field Office, Sunsari A total of 9 PLHIV (4 Male and 5 Female) participated in the meeting, maintaining all the precautions including proper distancing and proper use of mask. Meeting was facilitated by Case manager and PN. Discussion was done on Health Insurance, U=U, ART enrollment and re enrollment of all positive cases, importance of Index based partner testing and about viral load.

### Morang

AMDA EpiC Nepal conducted support group meeting on 24<sup>th</sup> February 2022 in Biratnagar Field Office, Morang a total of 20 PLHIV (12 Male and 8 Female) participated in the meeting, maintaining all the precautions including proper distancing and proper use of mask. Meeting was facilitated by Case Supervisor and PN. Discussion was done on Importance of COVID-19 vaccine & viral load importance & benefits. Among 20, 12 PLHIV participants sample was collection for Viral load testing.

### Monthly review meeting:

AMDA EpiC Nepal conducted monthly review meetings to review the progress and decide way forward on February 17<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022 in Jhapa and Sunsari district. In the meeting, there was the presence of PC, M&E Officer, HA, CBS, PN and Lab staffs. There was discussion on following:

- District and indicators wise target vs achievement.
- Minimizing data errors while filling up the forms
- QR code distribution and its recording
- Recording of 180 days follow up in a separate Register
- Follow-up of COVID Vaccination and its recording and reporting.
- Keeping Separate Register for PrEP
- Index Testing and IPV screening.

# **Online Activities**

- A total of 3 KPs and PPs were reached through online platform for HIV testing, STI, PrEP & Covid-19 prevention in Jhapa.
- Similarly, 16 KP & PPS were followed through phone for HIV testing, STI and COVID-19 prevention in Jhapa.
- Also 16 PLHIV (7 male and 9 female) were followed through phone for ART adherence, index partner testing, viral load testing and other services in Jhapa.

## **ARV Distribution Services**

• In this period, 6 PLHIV were supported for pill pick up from ART center in community and home by PN and CBS in Jhapa district.

# Hygiene kit Distribution:

- In this period 9 clients were distributed hygiene kit (5 male and 4 female) after the support group meeting in the Jhapa district in this month.
- In this period 16 KPs were distributed hygiene Kit after creative event in Sunsari district.

# Creative events:

# • Sunsari

Conducted creative event (PrEP focused) on 25<sup>th</sup> February in Itahari City clinic. A total of 16 FSWs participated in the event, maintaining all the precautions including proper distancing and proper use of mask. It was facilitated by PC, M&E, DIC Operator and CBS. There was discussion on importance of PrEP and its continuation. They are also taught about the personal hygiene and distributed hygiene kit to all participant.

# • Morang

Conducted creative event (PrEP focused) on 22<sup>th</sup> February in Biratnagar Field Office. A total of 10 FSWs, 6 (1.3) and 4 (1.2) were participated in the event, maintaining all the precautions including proper distancing and proper use of mask. It was facilitated CBS, PN and Field Supervisor. There was discussion on importance of PrEP and its continuation, HIV prevention & treatment. Where 3 KP restarted PrEP.

# • Jhapa

Conducted creative event (Covid-19, Prep focused) on 23<sup>rd</sup> February in Birtamode City clinic. A total of 11 (FSWs) participated in the event, maintaining all the precautions including

proper distancing and proper use of mask. It was facilitated by Covid Response officers, Case Manager, CBS & P.N. Discussion about Covid, covid hotline number and importance of covid vaccination & PrEP in aspect to HIV & AIDS was done. The program was interactive and the questions of participants were also solved in this matter.

## Monthly joint inter-Network meeting:

• Participated in the monthly meeting of ART center of BPKIHS on Feb.20, 2022 organized by Human Welfare Society and discussion was done on Viral load testing with privacy maintain, update viral load report in DHIS -2 tracker. Follow up of IIT clients.

## Viral Load campaign

- In this period altogether 28 viral load sample was collected in coordination with ART center, BDS sub-IPs and CCC at AMDA Nepal Birtamode city clinic, Jhapa and sent to Koshi Zonal Hospital.
- In this period altogether 47 viral load sample collection was done from AMDA Nepal Itahari city clinic in coordination with ART center, BDS Sub IPs, CCC and sent to Koshi Zonal Hospital.
- In Morang district total 18 viral load sample collection was done on February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2022 in coordination with ART Center and BDS sub-IPs and send to Koshi Zonal Hospital.

Also provide travel, communication and refreshment support to volunteers of Bhantabari POE, Sunsari
