Support group meeting:

Jhapa:

AMDA EpiC Nepal conducted support group meeting on 16th February, 2023 in Birtamode Field Office, Jhapa. A total of 14 PLHIV (6 male & 8 female) participated in the meeting. Meeting was facilitated by Case Manager, CBS & PN. Discussion was done about the ART Adherence, Importance of viral load and health insurance.

Sunsari

AMDA EpiC Nepal conducted support group meeting on February 13th, 2024 in Itahari Field Office, Sunsari A total of 13 PLHIV (2 Male and 11 Female) participated in the meeting. Meeting was facilitated by Case manager and PN. Discussion was done on Health Insurance, U=U, ART enrollment and re enrollment of all positive cases, Mental Health, importance of Index based partner testing and about viral load.

Morang

Online Activities

Jhapa: In this reporting period, 14 phone call were made for ART Adherence, support group & emotional support. Also, 12 high risk KP were communicated for HIV prevention, testing & PrEP services. Likewise, 5 KPs & PP were communicated through online mediums for different HIV related services.

Similarly, 5 clients booked HIV testing services through Merosathi & 5 arrived in the clinic & took the services.

Sunsari: In this period, 13 phone follow up were done among them 5 took services in the clinic. Similarly, 3 clients booked HIV testing services through MeroSathi & 3 arrived to clinic and took the services.

Morang: In this period, 2 clients booked HIV testing services through MeroSathi & 1 arrived to clinic and took the services.

Continued Medical Education (CME):

- In the period Continued Medical Education (CME) was conducted at Mechi Provincial hospital and Inaruwa Hospital on February 26th and 28th 2024 respectively. There was presence from all ward Incharge, administration. The session was launched by Sr. Pediatric Dr. Laxman Shrestha.

Creative events:

Sunsari

Conducted creative event (PrEP focused) on February 15th 2024 in Itahari City clinic. A total of 15 FSWs 11(1.2), 3(1.3), 1(67) participants. It was facilitated by DIC Operator and CBS. There was discussion on importance of PrEP and its continuation, HIV/STI testing, Mental Health. In this event PrEP restart was done by 1 FSWs and 4 refilled PrEP also 9 KPs done the STI screening and 4 HIV testing.

Morang

Conducted creative event on February 20^{st} 2024 in Biratnagar Field Office. A total of 12 female 6(1.2), 6(1.3) participants participated in the event. It was facilitated CBS, PN and Field Supervisor. There was discussion on importance of PrEP and its continuation, HIV prevention & treatment. In this event 3 of the participants were screened for STI/HIV, 1 of the participants started PrEP and 2 of the participants re-started PrEP.

Jhapa

Conducted creative event on February 22nd 2024 in Birtamode City clinic. A total of 15 (FSWs) were participated in the event which was facilitated by HA, DIC, CBS & P.N. Discussion was done about the importance of PrEP its advantages, sexually transmitted Infections (STIs) and its effects. In this event, 14 Kp tested for HIV & STI, 7 KP started PrEP, 2 restarted & 1 refilled. Also, 14 KPs were screened for STI, 8 were diagnosed and 8 were treated.

Stigma and Discrimination Reduction Training:

• Ilam

In this period Stigma and Discrimination Reduction training was conducted at Ward No.7 of Suryodaya Municipality, Ilam on the presidency of Ward President Mr. Lok Bahadur Rai on February 22, 2024 from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm. There are total 28 participants from different school and health institutions i.e School Teachers, Students, and Health Personnel. The opening session is done by Sr. ANM Gopi Maya Rai from Health Office Suryodaya Municipality and The Technical Session is done by HA-ART and ART Counselor along with Peer Navigator. In the training there was sharing of current status of HIV/AIDS, its causes, mode of transmission, signs & symptoms, preventive measures, concept of HIV related stigma and discrimination, its causes, types, effects and roles of Health workers and stakeholders to minimize such HIV related stigma & discrimination in the community.

Monthly joint inter-Network meeting:

- In this participated in the coordination meeting organized by Dharan Positive Group on February 9th, 2024 at Dharan CC Center. In the meeting there was presence from Dharan Municipality, ART Center, Mahila Sahayogi Samuha, Prayash Mahila Samuha, FPAN, Richmond, NAP+N. In the meeting there was discussion on preparation and celebration of International Condom Day supported in Sunsari district.

In the meeting there was sharing of program activities of Prayash Mahila Samuha, Stationary distribution to 25 PLHIV children of Sunsari district and Viral load transportation support cost to PLHIV family members supported by Itahari Municipality.
- In this period participated in the stakeholders meeting at Health Office Sunsari organized by Health office Sunsari on February 29th 2024. In the meeting there was presence of chief of DCC, chief of DAO, Mesu of district Hospital Sunsari, Health Office Sunsari, development partners, Local media reporters.
