2. KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

 We had conducted Annual Review Meeting in the presence of Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Chief Administrator, finance officer, PHO, team of health department and Incharge of Health Facilities of Gokarneshwor Municipality, team of AMDA Minds and AMDA Nepal on 27th January 2023 at Grand Norling Resort, Jorpati.

- Among 13 FCHV, 11 FCHV had done the door to door visit by using Kobo tool. Total 108 clients had been visited by FCHV, among all 38 were old followed up clients and 70 clients were new clients to whom they referred for the service.
- 1 **events** of one-day free breast & cervical cancer **screening camp** were conducted at AMDA Clinic, 21st January 2023 respectively. We conducted camp at AMDA Clinic in a **Single Visit Approach** as clients were benefitted with both service i.e. screening camp and diagnostic screening camp on the same day. However, the informed clients didn't came for colposcopy due to which colposcopy service was not provided on the day.
- **Diagnostic screening camp** were conducted at AMDA Clinic. A total of 54 clients benefited with the service, where 29 clients received the Mammogram service, and 25 client received the USG service on 21st January 2023. Among them 2 clients were visited for Mammogram service only.

The program was conducted smoothly as per the planned program schedule. The program was hosted by Achyut Sapkota. With the warm welcome speech by Dr. Yagya Raj Pathak, Secretary of AMDA Nepal and then the program was commenced by program officer. She presented the program in detail with the objective, activities, progress report, service report i.e. complied report and health facility wise report, achievement and challenges faced during an entire year. Also, shared the third year Program Planning along with the set targets.

Likewise, we had the discussion session with health facility incharge. All of them were thankful for such community service where most of the women are benefitted and their concept on screening services had been changed and also, this program had helped to increase the service number by their respective health facilities. However, there are still many beneficiaries in the community we had to provide the service so we need the support for the same. For instance, to provide diagnostic services which is only at AMDA Clinic and also requested on support on sustainability program as well after this third year.

Likewise, Chief Administrator of Gokarneshwor Municipality highlighted the importance of this program to community women, addressed the positive changes in health seeking behavior of women through educational activities conducted among women group and school program. Also, such practically implemented program need to be continued and we are looking forward for the support and we are ready to provide any kind of support for the same.

A total of 52 women attended the camp and among them 43clients benefitted from cervical cancer screening services (CCSS) and 49 clients benefited from breast cancer screening service (BCSS). Out of them, 1 women found with Benign Lump in the breast. We conducted camp at AMDA Clinic in a **Single Visit Approach** as clients were benefitted with both service i.e. screening camp and diagnostic screening camp on the same day. However, the informed clients didn't came for colposcopy due to which colposcopy service was not provided on the day.
